- Video Questions;

1. As a group, can you name all of the 10 commandments without looking? Exodus 20:1-7
2. What character traits of God are reflected in these commandments?
3. In the golden calf story and Moses' intercessory prayer, what reasons does he offer as to why God should not abandon the covenant? Ex.32
4. Read Genesis 12:1-3 and Exodus 19:16 closely. How are the themes of these two passages similar?
5. In Exodus 34:6-7 God presents to Moses a description of his character that is the most re-quoted line in the rest of the OT (see Psalms 103:8, 145:8, Jeremiah 32:18-19, Nehemiah 9:17, and Daniel 9:4) How are these character traits demonstrated in God's actions in the Exodus?
6. It seems that in the desert wandering that God was trying to teach the Israelites to listen for his voice, as a sheep listens for his shepherd. How would you like to be in the place of the Israelites and never knowing from one day to the next if you'd be traveling or not?
7. As a group, how many miracles can we name that God performed in the book of Exodus?

- Starter Question Suggestions to keep the conversation going

1. What is the easiest way for you to learn? visual, auditory, reading, or Kinesthetic (needing to get your whole body involved in the learning process)
2. Have you had the opportunity to share your faith with anyone this week?
3. What do you feel is the biggest mountain in front of you right now?
